

Companies report a variety of **challenges with Marketplace Notices:**



More than 60% are not sure if they've received a Marketplace Notice.



Midsized companies report that **information provided by employees is inaccurate.**



Large companies did not have enough information to identify employees, and they experience time delays.



Over 50% think that they are currently at risk of violating at least one aspect of annual health care reporting

Bottom line: All ACA requirements and potential penalties related to the employer mandate and reporting rules **remain in effect for this year and beyond.**
