## We could lose a day's work doing payroll

We were using QuickBooks to run payroll, and we had an individual in place who really didn't handle it very well. There was a box she was supposed to be checking every time, and she wasn't always doing it. And it did cost us some money – probably about \$25,000 to \$32,000 over two years or so.

It was also time-consuming. Payroll would take us three to four hours every time we did it, and that took away from production, it took away from sales support, it took away from all those things. Over the course of a month, we could lose up to a day's worth of work, plus. And then on top of it, we had to file all the taxes.

I was talking to a contractor that uses ADP, and a rep came in and told us what she could offer. We realized this was a gap area that we needed to get filled, and ADP was a perfect fit for us.
