

While most payroll providers only allow online statements to be viewed by current employees, ADP offers secure access to both active and terminated employees, reducing administrative burdens on HR staff. iPay provides employees secure, round-the-clock Internet access to payroll statements with iPay. They can view comprehensive salary information, including images of pay and earning statements, W-2 and W-4 forms, and other related data at any time. ADP also provides 24X7 IVR access to pay statements. Our Print-on-Demand units provide a simplified remote print option where required.

iPay also allows you to evolve your self-service strategy by providing user -centric functionality and intuitive navigation to quickly update direct deposit and W4 information real time, online.
